Combat Teams with Fagot and some Konkurs can take the launcher with them off the BMP/BMD IFV. BTR and similar APC teams always take their ATGW as it is carried inside the vehicle. BMD-1 and earlier BMP-1 teams resort to RPG-7 or RPG-16 once dismounted. For dismounted ATGW/SPG-9, AGS-17, and AA Support Platoons use the standard dismounted support platoon entries for stands with the same weapon system.
